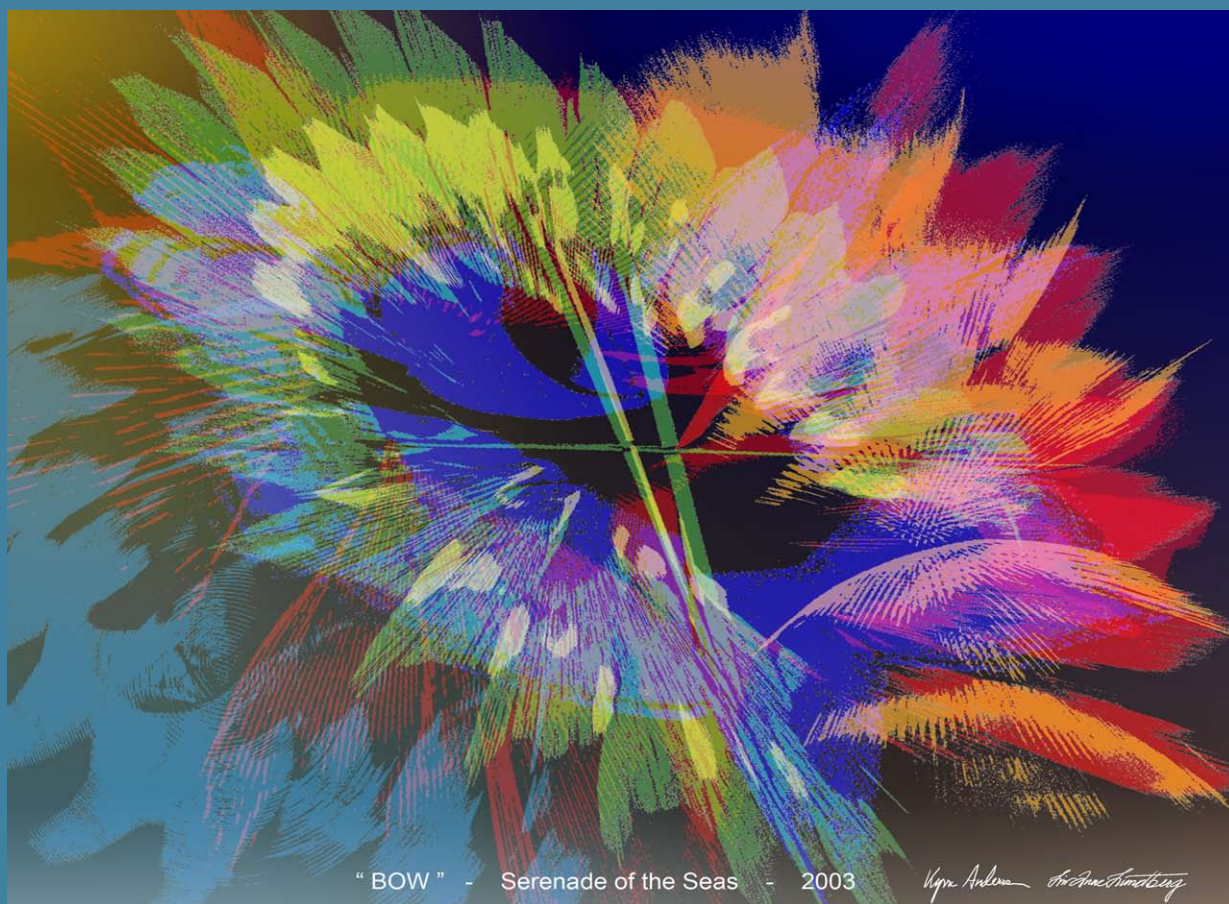


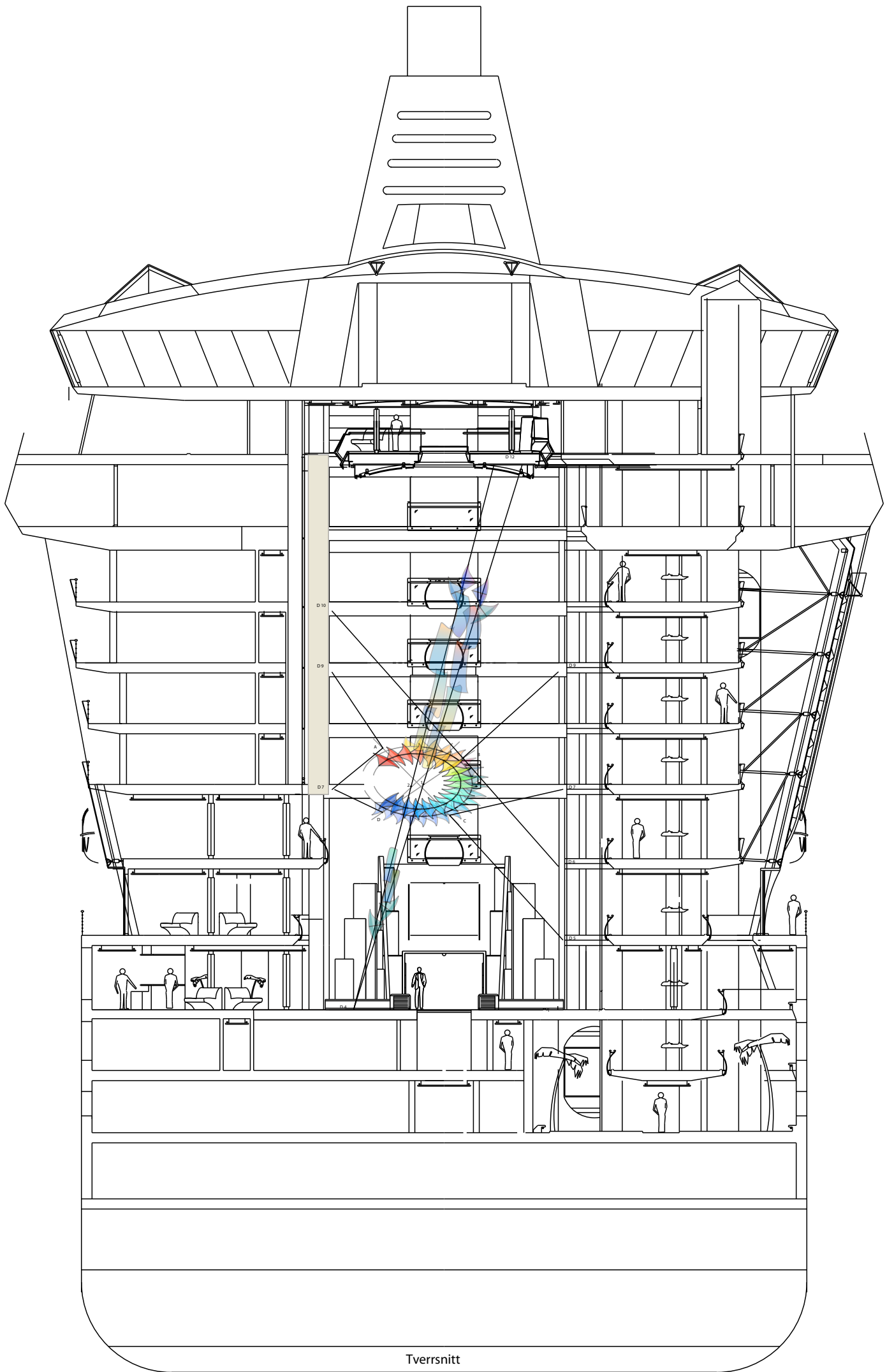

"Bow"

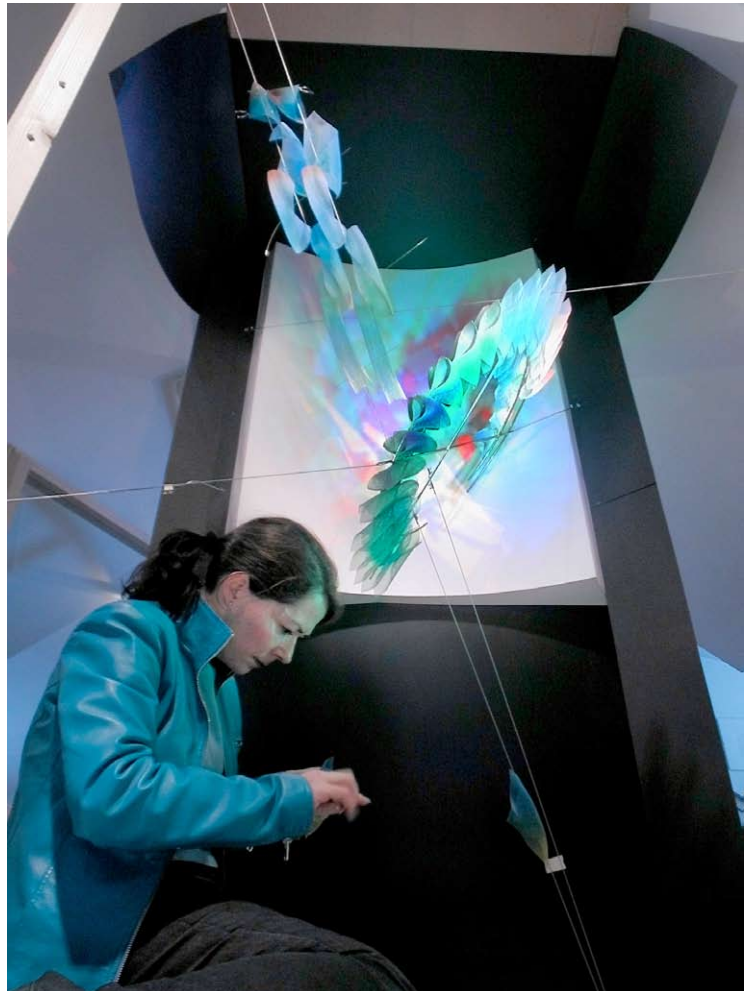
Stainless steel, lacquered and formed aluminum, mesh, light and gobos.

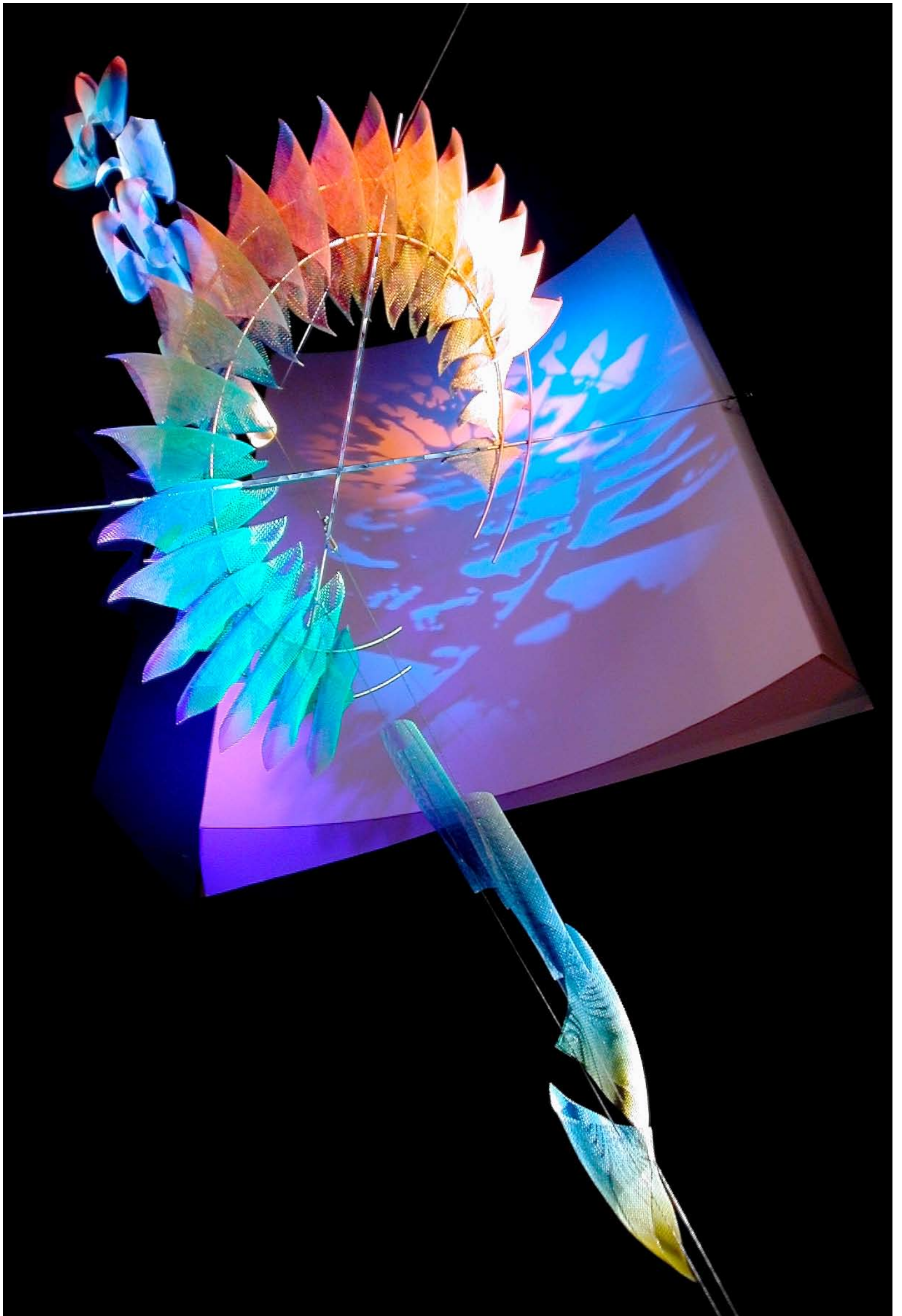

They have been involved in numerous projects on several cruise vessels, and have completed monumental commissions in Norway, including one of the main sculptures for the Norwegian Olympic Games at Lillehammer in 1994.

Artists' statement:

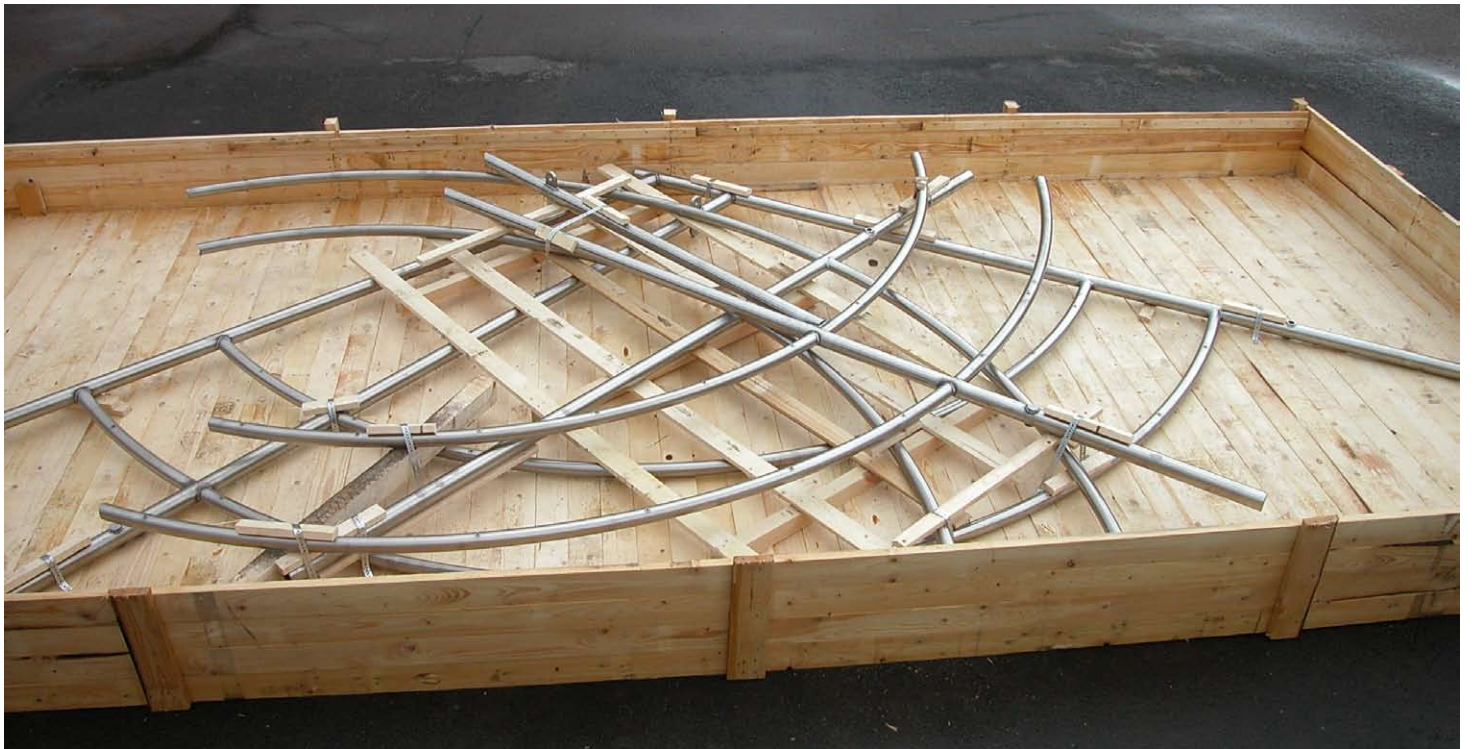
"When making sculptures intended to energize a space, it is natural for us to strive to express lightness and airiness. We have worked with themes such as wind, sound waves, cordless communication, etc. We aspire to render visibly something that cannot be seen, but which can be proven to exist. We often opt for a playful, naive approach to the topic in the beginning, even though the final result may come out differently .

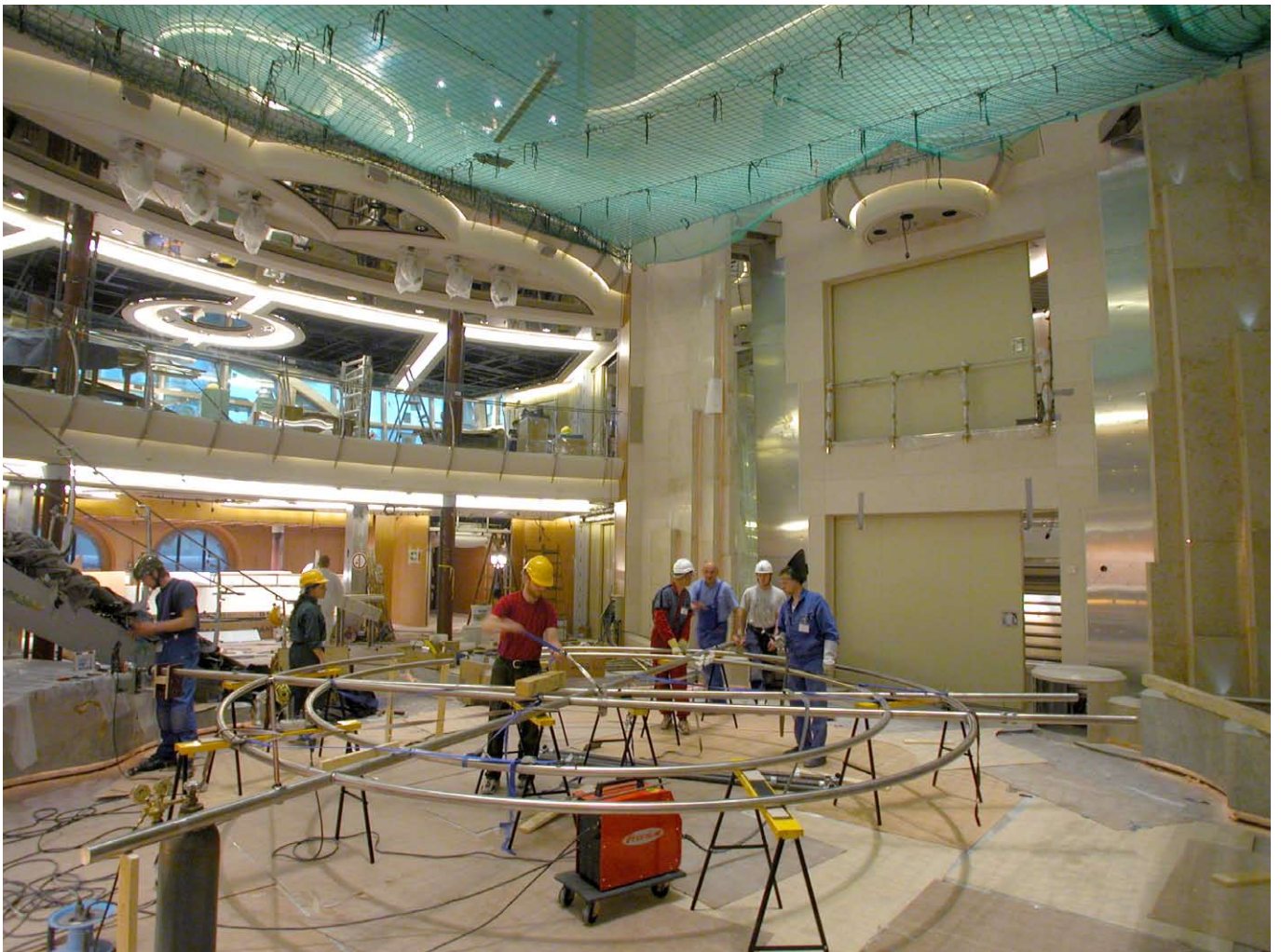
"In making the sculpture "Bow", we selected an optical phenomenon as the theme, i.e. a rainbow. While a rainbow is highly visible, it also signifies visions of treasure, riches and good fortune. We can either play with dreams or take them seriously."
